# EUROMOBIL concepts (1)

**JUST FOR YOU** – IN DEVELOPMENT

BASIS = needs of foreign exchange students in target countries

- ❖ questionnaire survey of needs
- ❖ needs analysis
- ❖ production of appropriate content
- ❖ student feedback in piloting



# EUROMOBIL concepts (2)

## JUST FOR YOU – IN CONTENTS

### SURVIVAL LEVELS

- for LWUTLs (CZ, FI, HU, PL, PT, RO)
- topics – basic everyday communication (getting around, shopping, lodging etc.)
- support language (English)

### ADVANCED LEVELS

- for WUTLs (EN, DE, FR)
- topics – academic communication (school registration, attending lectures, sitting for exams etc.)
- no support language



# EUROMOBIL concepts (3)

## JUST IN TIME

BASIS = autonomous learning

- programmes available for download 24/7
- self-study when need perceived by user
- „linear“ programme structure → mirror of chronological student experience
- non-linear programme structure → free study trajectory
